Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in open session on Tuesday, October 23, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Allen Curry and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Huggins was absent.

Tynes called the meeting to order and a quorum was established.

Clary led the invocation and Tynes followed with the pledges.

Kim Hinton stood in the public comments asking the court for permission to use the inner west side of the courthouse parking lot for trick or treating on the square because of all the construction be done on the sidewalks. This cannot be done due to early voting at the courthouse.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Wagner to approve line item transfers submitted. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 61 Page 590)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Wagner to approve the following consent agenda:

- B. Approve departmental reports submitted – None submitted
- C. Approve bills submitted for payment in the amount of \$48,414.81, payroll in the amount of \$50,375.84 and accounts payable payroll in the amount of \$39,706.61 (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 61 Page 591)
- D. Certificates of Continuing Education – None submitted

The motion carried unanimously.

Clary gave an update on his employee that had been injured at work. He told the court that he was making incredible progress.

Clary asked the court to make an exception to the rule on the Hamilton County Personnel policy, page 2 D-2 Vacation -on the initial accrual waiting period. Clary made a motion and seconded by Tynes to waive that waiting period for a precinct 4 employee who was injured on the job. The motion carried unanimously.

The court also spoke on the road and bridge funds in light of the recent rains we have had. Some counties were that were declared a disaster area because of the continuous rain. The commissioners were encouraged to try and stay ahead of things.
